## 2015 AUTUMN TEA FINISHES PLUCKING



From the end of Sept., autumn tea plucking started in Shizuoka prefecture. Japan has basically 4 tea seasons and pluck only 3 of them;

1st flush: end of April to beginning of May

2<sup>nd</sup> flush: June

3rd flush: August

4th flush: end of September to beginning

of October

Among those 4 seasons, farmers do not harvest 3<sup>rd</sup> flush. Due to tea pricing decreasing these years, harvesting and processing 3<sup>rd</sup> flush cost more than their income by selling them. Hence, by NOT harvesting 3<sup>rd</sup> flush, with little trimming, they leave the shoots growing until the 4<sup>th</sup> flush season to gain more weight.

As most people know, the pest quality and pricing come fromthe1st flush. As season goes on, yield increases but the price decreases.  $4^{\rm th}$  flush can be harvested about 800kg/ha (varies from one garden to another) but the price is about one third of the  $1^{\rm st}$  flush.

Here are some photos of  $4^{\rm th}$  tea harvesting from our neighborhood. It might be interesting comparing these gardens to your own tea estates.
